Term	Characteristic
Juicy	Succulent flavor, like from juicy/ripe fruit.
Peely	Reminiscent of cutting into a fruit peel.
Candy-like	Exaggeration of certain notes to make the flavor taste more like candy; may include cotton candy, brown notes, sugar-like notes and often done to induce nostalgia or make more kid-friendly.
Floral	Characteristic notes from flowers/flower petals like jasmine or lavender, slightly perfumy.
Fresh	Characteristic of uncooked fruit.
Terpeney	Like limonene with a slightly solvent-like taste.
Creamy	Characteristic of heavy cream or other similar dairy products.
Powdery	Slightly floral and perfumy quality or characteristic of tablets (powdery like a vitamin tablet).
Fleshy	Characteristic of the fleshy part of the fruit (as opposed to skin, peel, seeds, etc.).
Tart	Acidic, sour.
