Term	Characteristic
Candy-like	Exaggeration of certain notes to make the flavor taste more like candy; may include cotton candy, brown notes, sugar-like notes and often done to induce nostalgia or make more kid-friendly.
Green	Characteristic of green leaves, unripe fruit, stems, or vegetables.
Peely	Reminiscent of cutting into a fruit peel.
Ripe	Characteristic of food that has aged; for fruit, this is associated with a drop in green compounds and increase in esters.
Tropical	A fruity, sweet, and aromatic profile that evokes flavors found in fruits native to tropical regions.
Juicy	Succulent flavor, like from juicy/ripe fruit.
Soapy	Characteristic of a waxy, artificial, or perfumey flavor that resembles the taste or aroma of soap.
